In the wide scope of fishing spots in Manistee County, there's the Big Manistee River, dozens of jettie-terminating fisheries: the Little Manistee, for Rainbow and Greenie Trout; Bear Creek for Rainbow, Brook Trout and Greenie Trout; Pine Creek for Brook Trout and Greenie Trout; Pine River for Brook, Rainbow and Greenie Trout; Lake Michigan for Perch, Cisco, Herring, Walleye, Northern Pike, Bass and Manistee, Forage and Bear Lake for these and many others.

Hunt for deer and small game in Manistee County.

Hunt free from "no trespassing" signs in the Manistee National Forest. Game is plentiful in every section of the county and there's open water and plenty of cover. Last year bow and arrow deer hunting was especially good in this area.

If golf or tennis is your favorite—

You'll find it ideal here. Scenic 18-hole course overlooking Lake Michigan, one of the finest in the state. Yacht and tennis. And if you like tennis, there are excellent courts at Fifth Avenue Beach and Sands Park on Eighth Street. Existing Chamber of Commerce tournaments, too.

Like horseback riding or mushroom hunting?

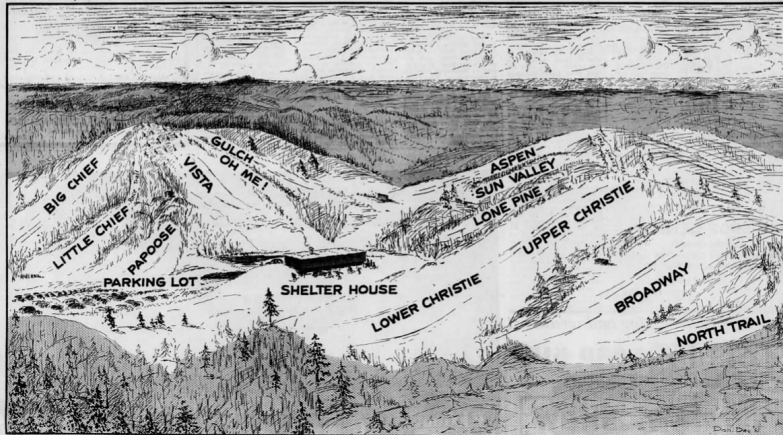

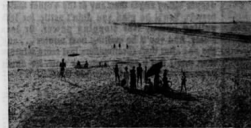

UTILITIES include an abundance of electrical power, natural gas and water supply.



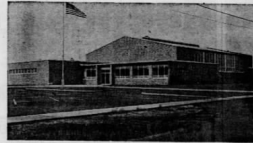
