

Ski Tow In Operation At Danforth Ski Hill Area

The ski tow in the Ski Hill area near Danforth is now in operation and will be available for use by ski enthusiasts over the weekend, the city recreation department announced today.

The facilities will be in operation from 2 through 5 p.m. both Saturday and Sunday. The slopes have a good snow base with light covering of new snow from Friday night.

A shelter house has been erected at the top of the ski hill for use by the skiers. The building also houses the power unit for the tow.

The area has been cleared of underbrush and small trees and

offers a good skiing slope in addition to a challenging jump for the better skiers. Supervision will be provided during the afternoon hours listed above.

Art Peterson, city recreation director, also announced today that the indoor rink at the U. P. fairgrounds exhibition building will be open for general skating Sunday afternoon from 1:30 to 4:30.

The general public is invited to take advantage of the facilities, for which there is no charge. The ice is in excellent condition at the indoor rink, as it is at the various outdoor rinks throughout the community, Peterson stated.
