

Calvin College Has Own Ski Runs

GRAND RAPIDS (UPI)—Calvin College will soon become only the third institution of higher learning to operate its own ski slopes actually on school grounds.

Only Michigan Tech at Houghton and Dartmouth College in New Hampshire own and operate on-campus ski slopes at the present.

The college said four members of its ski club conceived the idea for the slope on the northern edge of Calvin's Knollcrest campus.

The slopes two main runs will be 400 feet long, drop 50 feet vertically.

Future plans call for the creation of a toboggan run, skating rink with lighting for night use and a heated lodge.
