

Leelanau Boys, Girls Win from Boyne

Leelanau Schools won both phases of their dual ski meet with Boyne City Wednesday afternoon, the boys by disqualification, the girls by a comfortable margin in total elapsed time. Boyne City boys lost their chance for victory when several racers missed gates in the slalom runs and, as a result, failed to place the necessary four skiers with complete runs.

Winner of the boys downhill was Denny Hanson of Leelanau who led his team in a sweep of this division. Second was Craig Campbell with Andy Spence taking a third. Dick Tibbetts of Leelanau won the slalom with Dennis Christensen of Boyne second and Denny Hanson third. In the combined

times, Tibbetts and Hanson of Leelanau were one-two and Christensen of Boyne, third.

Kelly Woodbury of Leelanau was the winner in the girls downhill with Mary Lynn Bishop second, and Carol Rogers third. They too, skied for Leelanau. Pat Davis of Boyne City took top honors in the slalom with two Leelanau skiers, Miss Rogers and Miss Lynn Holly trailing. Carol Rogers was the winner in combined times with Miss Davis of Boyne and Miss Holly of Leelanau taking second and third.

The meet was held on the newly constructed hill at Leelanau Schools near Glen Arbor. Saturday the Indians will host Traverse City Central and Manistee in a triangular meet, starting at 9:30 in the morning.
