Del Flanagan is still in line for a welterweight championship bout, promoter Jack Raleigh said Saturday in St. Paul, despite loss of the title by Virgil Akins to Don Jordan in Los Angeles Friday night.

Raleigh admitted that Jordan's commitment to give Akins a return match might delay Del's title shot in St. Paul, but he added that it wasn't planned until spring anyway. Jordan's promise to be an active champion, defending against all challengers, was seen as increasing Flanagan's chances for a title bout.

Flanagan said he is considering offers to fight at Toledo, Ohio, LaCrosse, Wis., and Duluth in the meantime.
