NebraSki to Open But Not for Skiing

NebraSki probably will not open this season as a ski slope, but its lodge will be open for meetings, wedding receptions and parties, new owner Charlie Bystrek said Monday.

Bystrek, who also owns Nebraska Electronics Inc., had been a shareholder in NebraSki. He said he bought the remaining shares of stock last week from Lee Sapp, who had been corporation president.

The NebraSki land is southeast of Interstate 80 between Gretna and Ashland.
