

## 'Sun Valley' Ski Tow in Operation

With a four-inch fall of snow this week, winter sports conditions arrived for the first time this season, and it was announced today that the "little Sun Valley" ski tow will be in operation today and Sunday.

Until recently there has not been sufficient snow on the ground to permit use of the Sun Valley hills, in the town of Crescent.

The ski tow, while it is erected on the same hill as last winter, is on the south instead of the west slope, officials of the corporation managing the site declared. The tow is about 30 feet longer than the one used last year.

Another innovation this season is a parking lot—a 20-acre field near the Bernard Ames farm. The field has been cleared, but snow is not of sufficient depth to require plowing.

Skiers are expected to flock to the outdoors this week-end, the first good opportunity they have had to use that stored equipment which has been collecting dust for weeks.
