

## Big Bearskin Ski Facilities Open

Frank Erlitz, proprietor of the Big Bearskin ski hill near Goodnow, has announced that winter sports facilities are now open to the public or to private parties of 10 or more persons by appointment.

Facilities will be open to the public Sunday afternoons and evenings while groups may obtain private use of the hill on the other days.

Erlitz said that the ski hill is in excellent condition, and that the toboggan slide has been iced several times and is now exceptionally fast.

A high line has been installed and lighting facilities have been vastly improved for night sports, he said. New ropes have been added to the ski and toboggan tow. The glass warming house has been improved.

As in the past, toboggans may be rented at the hill. Big Bearskin Ski Hill still boasts the "longest toboggan in the world". The huge device has always delighted outdoor sports enthusiasts who have used it, and those who saw it in Tomahawk's Winter Frolic parade last February.

Hot refreshments will again be sold in the warming house.
