

Ski Bowl In K-M Area Is Going Strong

The Forest Lake Ski Bowl situated in the Kettle Moraine state forest was opened to the public for the first time Sunday. One hundred skiing, tobogganing, and ice-skating enthusiasts were on hand to try out the best winter sports facilities in the southern part of the state. Sixteen skiers came from the Chicago area in a special car attached to one of the regular Chicago and North Western trains. Other groups came from Milwaukee, Oshkosh and Fond du Lac.

Two down-hill ski runs, one 1,000 and the other 1,500 feet long, offered good sport for both the beginner and the expert. One ski-tow is in operation now and the second is expected to be in use before next Saturday. An 800-foot toboggan slide cuts through heavy woods and ends on Cranberry lake which is also used for skating. For those interested in overland skiing there are 160 acres of rolling land. Marked trails through the Mauthe and Forest lake woods offer a good opportunity for trial skiing.

The Forest Lake Ski Bowl is located on County Trunk Highway SS at the Sheboygan-Fond du Lac county line. It is 35 miles southwest of Sheboygan.
