

Marble Falls Resort

Marble Falls Resort and Convention Center occupies a high hilltop overlooking Dogpatch and has still more entertainment ideas for tourists. The newer of the two parks, Marble Falls features seasonal snow skiing and a year 'round ice skating rink. The park's 1,500-foot intermediate ski slope descends from the Marble Falls Ski Lodge down a steep hill, and here a chair lift transports skiers back to the top again. Two shorter, beginner slopes are adjacent to the intermediate one and are equipped with rope tows. The ski season runs December through March with the snow covering for the slopes produced by special snow cannons. The ski lodge and modern ice rink handle equipment rental and offer lessons to novices in both sports.

Marble Falls also includes a shopping mall, several restaurants, an Antique Automobile Museum, an Activities Center for games and dances and, of course, the heart of the resort complex, the octagonally shaped Convention Center. Future plans at the park call for the addition of a toboggan run, a bowling alley, tennis courts, a miniature golf course, shooting galleries, movies, an art gallery and an open-air amphitheater.

Tourists who come to either Dogpatch or Marble Falls will find a variety of lodging facilities available. The Marble Falls Inn and Dogpatch Motel provide motel accommodations while beautiful Swiss chalets and the Marble Falls Apartments have complete kitchen facilities. There is also Campark with complete hookups for campers.
