

# Nor-Ski Runs

## Perfect for experts and beginners



With five slopes ranging from "expert to "bunny", the Nor-Ski Runs just north of Decorah offers something for everyone interested in downhill skiing.

One rope and two cable tows will take the winter sport enthusiast to the top of the five slopes. Hills vary in length and decline to fit the expert, intermediate, beginner, and bunny skier.

Along with the wide variety of experiences, Nor-Ski offers a chalet with concession stand, two slopes lighted for night skiing and ski instructions.

Tow fee daily rates run \$6 for students through high school and \$7 for adults. Evening rates are \$5 for students and \$6 for adults. Student rental fees run \$6 for skis, boots and poles, and \$7 for adults. Ski instructions are available for \$3 per person in a group setting, or \$6 for private lessons. Season tickets are also available. (Rates are subject to change.)

Hours at Nor-Ski are 11 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Saturday and Sunday, 5:30 p.m. to 9 p.m. Tuesday and Thursday. The runs are closed Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Special holiday openings will be announced.
