

Scott County Park

All types of winter sports abound in Scott County Park located 10 miles north of Davenport on Hwy. 61: sledding, tobogganing, skiing, hiking, cross country skiing, ice fishing and camping. You can even go deer watching, and the best time of day is near dusk. The park is open from 8 a.m.-10 p.m. daily. A patrol is on duty. Ice skating is available on old Lake Odetta which has been flooded and provided with lights and a warming house. Most areas of the park are also open for cross country skiing, as well as sledding and tobogganing. Hours that the ski tow is in operation are 4-10 p.m. Thursday and Friday, and noon-10 p.m. Saturday and Sunday. Ice fishing is allowed on Cody Lake. The enclosed warming area with two fireplaces and heated restrooms is the Whispering Pines Pavilion.
