

Steamboat Rock Winter Sports Jamboree Events

STEAMBOAT ROCK — The second annual All Iowa Winter Sports Jamboree will be Saturday, Jan. 29, at Steamboat Rock. "Capitol Cup" skiing and skating races have been added to the schedule of events.

The Capitol Cup skating race will be at 11 a.m. It is an open race with no age or skill restrictions. Entrants should register before 10:30 a.m. The Capitol Cup ski race, also an open race, is set for 3:30 p.m. Entrants should register before 3 p.m. There is a \$1 entry fee for each contestant.

Entertainment

Lt. Governor Roger W. Jepsen will present the "Capitol Cup" to the winner of the skating race at the noon luncheon. Hosts for the informal luncheon are State Senator and Mrs. James Potgeter and Representative and Mrs. Richard Welden. The "New Dawn Singers" from Newton will entertain.

The Winter Jamboree is also featuring a "Mini" Snow Sculpture Contest, surprise sports awards, gate prizes,

skating, tobogganing and skiing. The grounds are open from 9 a.m. to 10:30 p.m.

Prizes

The snow sculptures can measure no larger than 2 feet by 2 feet by 2 feet. Prizes will be given to children and adults. The surprise sports award will be given in skiing, skating and snowmobiling with citations going to juniors, teens and adults. Persons experienced in each field will act as judges. Gate prizes are a hand knit afghan or a whole ham.

Leading the State House Safari will be the speaker of the Iowa House of Representatives, William Harbor of Henderson, and Deputy Secretary of Agriculture, Robert H. Lounsberry of McCallsburg. The State House Safari will be at 2 p.m. The Early Bird Safari is at 10:30 a.m. and the Moonlight Safari at 7 p.m. The safaris are guided trail rides along the scenic Iowa River.

"Tubing" will be another Jamboree highlight. "Tubing" is a snowmobile associated sport. A tractor inner tube is pulled behind a snowmobile to give tube passengers fun and thrills.

Cards and refreshments will be available all day in the main lodge which will be open at 9 a.m. There is a bridge tournament at 2 p.m.
