At Decorah, Paul Strand, president of the Decorah Ski Club, reports that the conditions there are "excellent and the best ever." Waterloo Ski Club president Paul Stone says the jump "should be in awfully good shape." There will be two tows in operation Saturday and Sunday. The jump opens at 10 a. m. both days.
