WINNIPEG (CP) — Ski report issues late Thursday:

MOUNT GLENORKEY: Conditions good, six inch base, two inches of new snow, all tows operating, open from 9:30 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. daily.

STONY MOUNTAIN: 12 inch base, no new snow, conditions good.

HOLIDAY MOUNTAIN: 12-30 inch base, three inches new snow, conditions very good.

AGASSIZ: 10-20 inch base, two inches new snow, conditions good to very good.

BIRCH: Eight to 10 inch base, two inches new snow, conditions good.

SNOW VALLEY: six inch base, no new snow, conditions good.

MOUNT EVERGREEN: Eight inch base, two inches new snow, conditions good.

SUGAR HILLS: 35 inch base, two inches new snow, conditions very good.

MINNEDOSA SKI VALLEY: Two to three inch base, two inches new snow.

SPRING HILL: Five to 20 inch base, making snow continuously, conditions very good.
