

Entire County Invited to 'Snow Party' at Allegan

ALLEGAN, Mich., Feb. 1 — The Allegan Improvement Association today issued a blanket invitation to the entire county to attend a "snow party" and free weiner roast at the Allegan ski run on Wednesday, starting at 7:30 p.m.

Franklin Douglas will serve as activities chairman, with free food and drink being supplied by Hardings Market, Valley Fruit Market and the Superior Dairy, according to Clifton Schelhas, chairman of the Allegan Improvement Association's resort and recreation committee.

While the public hill has been called a "ski run," it gets more use by the sled and toboggan set, Schelhas pointed out. The steep slope is more than 150 yards high, followed by an unlimited level run.

Facilities include an old school bus converted to a warm-up shack with heaters and a telephone and an electrically operated rope lift—all of which were donated by local residents.
