

Northport Ski Area Operating

NORTHPORT— A group of young women took ski lessons from Robert Spinniken of East Leland at the ski hill west of Northport Tuesday. Weather permitting, lessons will be given next Tuesday and all interested young women are invited.

The ski area is in its third year of operation and is governed by the North Leelanau Ski Association, Inc. and is comprised of 13 Northport and Leland business and professional men.

John W. Travis of Northport is president; Stanley Ball of Leland, vice-president; and Robert Reuhrer of Northport, secretary-treasurer.

The Northport Lions Club originated the idea for the ski hill, which is 150 feet high. There is a 500-foot rope tow and a metal warming house.

Operating funds are obtained from volunteer \$5 family memberships and a \$300 contribution from the Leelanau Township Foundation.
