

Cadillac To Recycle Its Snow

CADILLAC — (AP) — Mother Nature, and local ski enthusiasts, will receive an assist from Cadillac officials, who plan to transfer mountains of snow now clogging city parking lots to the municipal ski slope.

By plowing out local parking lots and hauling the snow to the city ski slope, city officials said they could solve two problems at once.

The snow from the city parking lots will add another eight inches to the base on Diggins Hill, said Douglas Lape, recreation director for this northwestern Lower Michigan community.

While private ski resorts in the Cadillac area have snow-making machinery to keep their slopes properly covered, the city does not.
