

The Cheboygan County ski enthusiasts are seeking a \$400,000 loan from FHA in hopes of making Griswold a first class ski resort.

Skiers stopped zooming down the slopes of Griswold in 1959, 10 years after it opened. It was no Boyne Highlands or Nub's Nob, but it did fill the bill for a lot of skiers in the Indian River area.

Its new backers envision a bigger and better ski area, but yet one that would be operated on a non-profit basis--initially, anyway. Revenue will be used to pay off the government loan and for investment in new facilities.
