

New Winter Park Now Operating

Indian River Ski Area Plans Formal Opening

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INDIAN RIVER—Formal opening of the new Griswold Mountain Ski area a mile north of here on US-27 has been set for New Year's Day. State officials are expected here to participate in the program.

The new ski park, opened for public use last weekend.

A new ski tow has been installed and is in operation and a warming building constructed and placed in use.

No charge is made for using the park if skiers do not use the tows.

One ski run at the park is three-quarters of a mile long. The top of the ski hill commands views of both Mullett and Burt Lakes.

A large ice rink is to be constructed at the foot of Griswold mountain this winter. Plans call for the selection and coronation of a Ski queen during the formal opening ceremonies on Jan. 1.

One of the features of the new park is its availability to a main highway, skiers being able to park on the shoulders of US-27 and walk to the skiing runs.
