

Kandahar Invites Ski Enthusiasts

HARTLAND—Kandahar Ski Club's open house will be held Sunday Dec. 7 from 1 to 4 p.m., at the club grounds located on Foley Road between Hartland and Fenton roads.

Take 23 north past Hartland to Center Road, east on Center Road to Hartland Rd, north on Hartland Road to Foley Road, east on Foley to Kandahar.

Kandahar Ski Club is dedicated to provide economical family skiing. Kandahar owns and operates its own facilities exclusively for its members and their

guests. Kandahar facilities consist of 117 acres, 8 slopes served by 8 rope tows and one poma lift, a rustic lodge, snow making and snow grooming equipment. Kandahar is lit for night skiing.

Besides economical family skiing Kandahar offers uncrowded slopes, free beginning lessons, a free ski jump school unequalled in this state, social activities, Alpine and Nordic competitive skiing, and advanced lessons at a modest fee.

Kandahar is about 30 years

old. It operated for many years as a natural snow area in the Pontiac Lake Recreation Area. In 1964 the members decided to invest in snow making equipment and better tows. Kandahar was able to purchase the Summit Ski Club.

Since that date five years ago, many improvements have been made, a new Poma lift was installed, hills groomed, a new east slope opened, lodge improved, lighting improved, snow making improved and trails cut.
