

Ski Slide Ready For Club Members

Lansing Ski club members were set Friday to try out their "staves" Saturday on the hill east of the Walnut Hills Golf club.

Wednesday night's snow fitted the club property for the initial display of skill this winter, R. C. Stebbins, president of the club, said.

One tow will be in operation Saturday, he said, and two others will be ready for use the following week.

Use of the hill, which has been raised 15 to 20 feet the past summer and fall, will be limited to club members and guests, he said.

Several runs have been brushed out in the wooded area, according to Stebbins, for the ski enthusiasts.
