

Lansing Ski Club Will Open Sunday

Lansing Ski club will dedicate its 60-acre winter sports site next Sunday afternoon at 3:30 o'clock, C. R. Stebbins, president of the group, said Wednesday.

Gov. G. Mennen Williams, a ski enthusiast, has been invited to participate in the ceremonies. He is to be made an honorary member of the group.

Mayors Ralph W. Crego of Lansing and Richard P. Lyman, Jr., of East Lansing also are being asked to join in the official opening of the club property east of Walnut Hills golf course. Lyman is an officer of the club.

Governor Williams is to be presented with the official shoulder patch of the Lansing Ski club during the ceremonies, according to Mr. Stebbins.

By the week-end, Stebbins said one of the two permanent tows

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would be in service. A portable tow now is being used. The club also intends to install floodlights, so the runs can be utilized at night.

Since last season the club has acquired the 60-acre tract, which it used as the center of its activities. The main hill has been raised 15 to 20 feet and the wooded area has been "brushed" to establish "runs."

Tobogganing also is expected to be provided by the club to members. One of the hills is being considered as a center for the tobogganing activities.

For the official opening, Stebbins pointed out, the sports site would be thrown open to the public.
