

# New Winter Sports Area Opening

The opening of a new winter sports park located in the Thumb area is announced this week by its manager, James M. Moore of Caro.

Called Lee-tow winter sports area and located on M-46, 11½ miles west of M-53 or three and one-half miles east of M-24, it will provide near-by skiing to many who previously had to drive several hours.

A tow especially for beginners will be available. Ski instruction along with rentals, warming shelters and hot lunches will also be available.

Toboggan runs and an ice skating rink are now under construction and are expected to be completed by January 1.

Lee-tow will open this year with two rope tows and runs up to six and seven hundred feet. Night skiing is anticipated but it is not definite at this time. This park will be open only weekends and holidays for the 60-61 season.

Since there will be no snow machine at Lee-tow it is suggested that people interested in visiting the park, watch for posted slope reports made available by newspaper, radio and TV.
