

Work Pushed on New Ski Slope

Alpena Plans 'Bee' at Lookout Hills Sunday

ALPENa—Work on the new Alpena Lookout Hills ski slopes, 18 miles south of here, is nearing completion, Alpena Chamber of Commerce Secretary Frank Catto announced this week.

Two motors to operate ski tows and a shed to house one of them were placed at the slopes last weekend by a group of volunteers. Another work "bee" is slated this weekend. M. W. Catto, of Flint, brother of the Alpena C. of C. head and a ski professional, inspected the slope Sunday.

He found the drop on the hill was 130 feet by altimeter measurement. He said he believed the area could be developed into an outstanding winter sports attraction.
