

Ski Tow Is Now Ready

The ski tow in Central park here is ready for use and will be put in operation for the first time Saturday, T. H. Reque, city recreation director, announces.

The tow will be operated by Gus Nye from 2 to 5 p. m., and 7 to 9 p. m., Saturday, and at the same time on Sunday. If patronage warrants it, the tow also will be operated several nights a week, the recreation director said.

The project is sponsored by the city recreation department.

City crews installed rope, made slopes on the hills, readied the motor and adjusted cables and lights were installed by Art Allen, assisted by Gus Nye. Two transformers for the tow have been loaned by the Edison Sault Electric Company.
