

Central Park Ski Hill Readied

The request of the Thunder Bowl Ski Club for use of the ski tow, now in Central Park, has been tabled by the Recreation Commission, which announces it will operate the ski hill this winter.

The slopes of the hill have been reconditioned and sand difficulties experienced last year will be corrected. New rope has been purchased for the tow.

Posts and poles for the tow have been replaced and the hill is now ready for use when snow conditions permit. Terry Betrand will be in charge of the program. An assistant will be named later.
