A crew of eight young men and eight young women from the Clear Lake Youth Conservation Corps spent two days of hard work improving Munising's Maple Mountain Ski Hill. They protected the ski hill from erosion by grass seeding and spreading hay mulch and fertilizer over the bulldozed areas of the hill. Using shovels, they removed most of the bad earth bumps which have been a hazard to the beginner skier. They also chopped out numerous small stumps. Their efforts have made Maple Mountain a better ski area for the coming skiing season.
