

Guide to Winter Sports in Michigan

Ski Resorts And Equipment

Upper Peninsula

1 — MONT RIPLEY: Open slopes, 2,000 ft. 1 new T-bar and rope tows.

2 — PORCUPINE MOUNTAIN: 8 slopes, 2,800-4,300 ft. Double chair lift, 4 tows, 1/2 mile cross-country run.

3 — MT. ZION: Four 1,200-ft. slopes; 2 downhill and 2 slalom. 1 tow with breakoff. Tobogganing. Open runs. and Thurs. nights and weekends.

4 — BIG POWDERHORN: 14 slopes, longest 1 mile; beginner, novice, intermediate and expert trails. 2 double-chair lifts, 1 T-bar and 2 rope tows.

5 — INDIANHEAD MOUNTAIN: 9 runs; 3 slopes, 3,000-5,000 ft. Triple chair lift; double chair lift; 2 T-bars; 2 tows. Snow-making equipment.

6 — MT. JOY: 1,000-ft. slope with two, several beginners' slopes.

7 — BRULE MOUNTAIN: 6 slopes, 4,000 ft. T-bar lift; 4 tows; chair lift. Cross-country trails. Snow-making equipment.

8 — CRYSTELLA SKI HILL: Several slopes; 2 tows. Junior jump. Night skiing and skating. Tobogganing.

9 — PINE MOUNTAIN: 12 slopes and trails. 2 double chair lifts; 4 tows. Snow-making and grooming equipment. World's highest artificial ski jump.

10 — ALQUA RECREATION AREA: 3 slopes; 400-1,000 ft. 3 tows Junior jumping hills. Cross-country course. Toboggan run. Night skiing.

11 — CLIFFS RIDGE SKI RESORT: 6 slopes, 500-5,300 ft. 2 T-bar lifts; 2 tows. Snow-making and snow-grooming equipment.

12 — GLADSTONE SKI PARK: Several slopes; 4 tows. Night skiing.

13 — THUNDER BOWL: 5 slopes, 2 tows. Cross-country trails. Tobogganing. Skating.

14 — BIG VALLEY: Open slopes; 2 tows.

15 — BRICE'S HILL: 1 slope, 1 tow.

16 — IROQUOIS MOUNTAIN LODGE: 6 runs, 1900 to 3000 feet. Beginners, intermediate and expert slopes. Cross-country trails. Double chair lift, 2 tows.

West Michigan

17 — BOYNE HIGHLANDS: 3 miles north of Harbor Springs. 17 runs, 2 triple chair lifts; pomalift; 2 T-bars. Snow-making equipment.

18 — NUB'S NOB: 12 slopes, 1,000 to 5,200 ft. 2 double chair lifts; 5 rope tows, pomalift. Snow-making equipment.

19 — PETOSKEY WINTER SPORTS PARK: 2 slopes, 1 tow. 2 skating trails. Tobogganing. Jump-jumper runs.

20 — MT. MOSAUBA: 5 slopes, beginners area. 3 tows. Lighted. Skating. Tobogganing.

21 — WALLOON HILLS: 9 slopes, 2,300 to 4,000 ft. Several trails. T-bar lift; pomalift; 3 tows.

22 — THUNDER MOUNTAIN: 12 runs, 1,800 to 3,000 ft. Beginners area. Double chair lift, T-bar lift, pomalift; 2 rope tows.

23 — BOYNE MOUNTAIN: 14 ski runs; 1,000 to 6,000 ft. 4 passenger chair lift; 5 double chair lifts; T-bar lift; 3-bar lift; rope tows. Snow-making equipment.

24 — GLACIER HILLS: 7 slopes; 3 trails; 4 tows.

25 — MAPLEHURST SKI AREA: 6 ski slopes, 4 trails; pomalift rope tow.

26 — SHANTY CREEK LODGE: 13 slopes; trails 2 pomalifts; 2 double chair lifts, T-bar lift; T-bar lift; rope tows.

27 — SUGAR LOAF MOUNTAIN: 30 acres of ski runs, double chair lift; T-bar. Snow-making equipment.

28 — TIMBER LEE: 4 ski slopes including beginners' trails. Pomalift; rope tow.

29 — TRAVERSE CITY HOLIDAY: 14 slopes. T-bar lift; 8 tows. Night skiing. Snow-making equipment and tucker.

30 — MT. MANCERONA: 18 ski runs and trails; 300-1,000 ft. T-bar lift; pomalift; 2 tows. Tournament hill. Dishpan hill. Slough rides.

31 — CHIMNEY CORNERS: 5 slopes. 5 tows. Lighted. Toboggan and sledding hills.

32 — BEAR HILLS: 7 ski slopes; 2 tows. Separate lifts and tows for toboggans and sleds. Cross-country trails. Slough rides.

33 — CRYSTAL MOUNTAIN: 12 ski runs. Chairlift; pomalift; 2 tows. Snowmaking equipment.

34 — BRIAR HILL: 5 slopes, 190-2,000 ft. Slalom slope. 1 ski jump.

35 — CABERFAE: 35 ski runs, 25 acre slalom bowl. Down hill race course. Intermediate bowl, 2 jumps, 6 T-bar lifts; 10 tows. Snow-making equipment.

36 — MCGUIRE'S WINTER SPORTS AREA: Toboggan run, rope tow. Lighted.

37 — MISSAUKEE MOUNTAIN: 7 ski runs, 1,000 to 3,000 ft.; 3 trails; 2 tows.

38 — BIG M SKI AREA: 17 ski runs. Double chairlift; T-bar; 11 tows. Snow-making equipment.

39 — WARD HILLS: 9 ski runs. Lighted. Trails. Rope tow.

40 — NEWAYGO WINTER SPORTS PARK: Ski slope 2 tows. Night skiing and tobogganing.

41 — MONO RIDGE: 10 ski runs. Rope tows. Trails. Lighted. Snow-making equipment.

42 — BRADY'S HILLS: 9 ski runs. Electric rope tows. 100 cases of liquor and wine.

43 — CANNONSBURG SKI AREA: 10 ski runs, 4 trails, T-bars, 4 rope tows.

44 — PANDO SKI AREA: 7 ski runs. Beginner's area. 5 tows. Snow-making equipment.

45 — B R O C K PARK: Ski slopes, 2 toboggan runs. Rope tow. Skating.

46 — GRAND HAVEN SKI BOWL: 5 slopes, 5 tows. Cross-country trails. Night skiing.

47 — INDIAN HILLS: 3 ski runs. Rope tows. 2 toboggan runs. Special toboggan and return conveyor furnished.

48 — HILL-LOU HEIGHTS: 6 tows.

49 — CAROUSEL MOUNTAIN: 13 ski slopes and trails. Double chair lift; T-bar lift; T-bar lift; rope tow. Snow-making equipment.

50 — ESKAR SKI HILLS: 6 slopes, 4 tows. Snow-making equipment. Night skiing.

51 — TIMBER RIDGE: 8 ski runs, 8 tows. Snow-grooming equipment. Lighted.

52 — FRY'S WINTER SPORTS PARK: 3 toboggan runs; toboggans furnished. Rope tow. Skating.

53 — ECHO VALLEY: 8 toboggan runs. Rope tow. Toboggans furnished free. Night tobogganing. Snow-making equipment. Skating.

54 — HINDER PARK: 1 lift for skiing, tobogganing, sledding. Rope tow.

55 — S WISS VALLEY: 10 slopes, 10 rope tows. Night skiing.

56 — PINNACLES SKI RESORT (El Mac Hills): ski slopes and trails. Double chairlift; tows. Snow-making equipment.

57 — SYLVAN KNOBS: 17 slopes. 3 pomalifts, 7 tows.

58 — OTSEGO SKI CLUB: 10 ski runs, 2 chair lifts; T-bar lift; 6 tows.

59 — NEW AU SABLE LODGE: Several slopes and lifts; beginners' slope. 2 Pomalifts. Night skiing.

60 — SNOW VALLEY: 21 slopes, 9 rope tows; 2 pomalifts. Cross-country trail.

61 — SHERIDAN VALLEY: 8 slopes, 3 tows; 1 pomalift.

62 — PONDO SKI RESORT: 5 slopes, 3 tows.

63 — MT. MARIA: 5 slopes, 600 to 1,500 ft. Pomalift; 2 rope tows. Snow-making and grooming equipment.

64 — MT. FREDERICK: 15 slopes, 3 T-bar lifts; 3 tows, cross-country trails. Snow-making equipment. Night skiing.

65 — MID MOUNTAIN: 11 runs, up to 1,500 ft. 4 tows.

66 — GRAYLING WINTER SPORTS PARK: 20 ski runs and slopes, 1,000 to 1,500 ft. T-bar lift; 12 rope tows. Snow-making equipment.

67 — SKYLINE: 9 slopes. Chair lift; 8 tows. Night skiing. Wed., Fri. and Sat. Cross-country trails.

68 — INDIAN HILLS SKI PARK: Ski runs and trails. Electric rope tow.

69 — OGDEN HILLS: 6 slopes, T-bar lift, 2 rope tows.

70 — HOUGHTON LAKE SNOW BOWL: 27 runs, 13 tows. Snow-making equipment.

71 — SNOWMAKE MOUNTAIN: 10 slopes, 5 tows. Cross-country trails. Slough bowl.

72 — MAJOR MOUNTAIN: 10 ski runs; 4 tows.

73 — MOTT MOUNTAIN: 12 runs; beginners' area. 4 tows. Snow-making and grooming equipment. Night skiing.

74 — APPLE MOUNTAIN: 7 slopes; 8 tows. Snow-making and grooming equipment. Night skiing.

75 — LANING SKI AREA: Private club, closed on Sunday. Open nights and Saturday to public. Ski bowl, 7 runs. Snow-making equipment.

Southeast Michigan

76 — MT. HOLLY: Chair lift; 2 T-bars; 10 rope tows. Snow-making equipment. Slalom racing program. Night skiing.

77 — MT. CHRISTIE: 7 slopes; longest 1,200 ft. 1 pomalift; 1 T-bar lift; 8 tows. Snow-making equipment. Night skiing.

78 — DRYDEN: 14 mile of open slopes; 600-1,200 ft. 8 tows. Snow-making equipment. Night skiing.

79 — JACK PINE VALLEY: 3 slopes; 4 rope tows. Snow-making equipment. Cross-country trails. Night skiing.

80 — MT. GRAMPAIN: 8 slopes; pomalift; 8 tows. Snow-making equipment. Ski jumping. Night skiing.

81 — ALPINE VALLEY: 9 slopes; longest 1,500 ft. 2 chair lifts; 4 T-bar lifts; 12 tows. Snow-making equipment. Night skiing. Ski jumping. Ice skating.

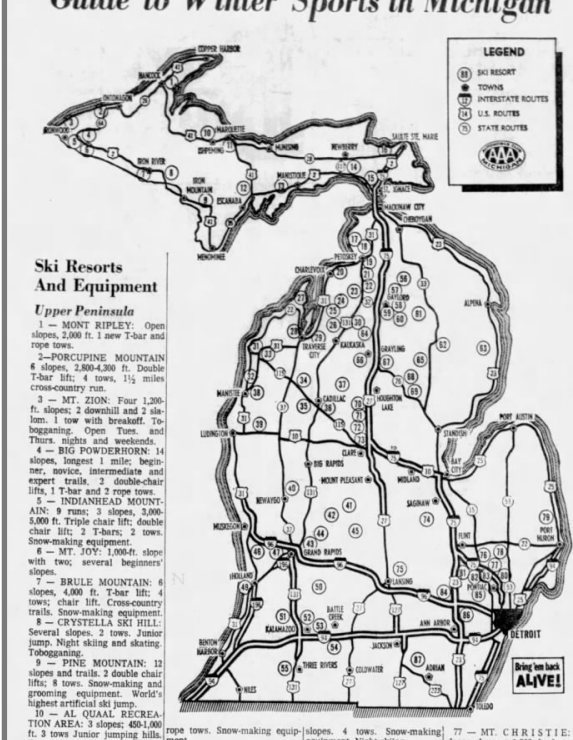
82 — SILVER BELL VILLAGE: 5 slopes, 200 to 1,300 ft. 2 T-bar lifts, 10 rope tows. Snow-making equipment. Night skiing.

83 — PINE KNOB: 6 slopes up to 2,000 ft.; several trails. 2 chair lifts; rope tows. Snow-making equipment. Night skiing.

84 — MOTT BRIGHTON: 6 ski runs including 2 beginners' T-bar lift; 5 rope tows. Snow-making equipment. Night skiing.

85 — KENNINGTON METROPOLITAN PARK: Tobogganing and sledding on moderate slopes. Skating and ice fishing on Kent Lake. Natural snow only.

86 — IRISH HILLS SPORTS PARK: 18 slopes; longest 1,500 ft. 3 T-bar lifts; 4 tows. Snow-making equipment. Sleigh and bob sled runs. Tobogganing. Lighted. Ice skating.

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Mississippi Governor at Raided Party

JACKSON, Miss. (UPI)—The champagne was iced and the local gentry turned out in their finest Friday night, but Chief Deputy Tom Shelton decided not to wait until after the ball was over.

He and his men went crashing into the plush Jackson Country Club, used a sledge to smash down a door to a storeroom and carted off 100 cases of liquor and wine.

Gov. Paul Johnson, who made a give-me-prohibition-legal liquor speech this week arrived at the country club shortly after the raid.

"Can't you do something about this," complained one of the thirty, finely-groomed women.

"I made a stand, I took my chance," said the governor of the only dry state in the Union.

Johnson told the legislators Thursday that Mississippi's liquor policy had made it the "laughing stock of the nation."

Burned To Death
