

SKI TOW ARRIVES

Ironwood—The new 1,200-foot gasoline powered ski tow, to be installed on the east slope of Mount Zion, arrived in Ironwood yesterday and installation work will begin immediately. Plans and specifications drawn up from the profile of the slope by the manufacturing company came in the mail today and the enginehouse and carrying poles will be spotted first.

The ski tow will be erected to the left of the skiing area. To obtain the concave slope necessary to avoid dragging of the lower rope which pulls the skiers up the hill the installation crew will cut down two knolls near the center and bottom of the hill. The site was chosen to get the tow off the main skiing area, thus avoiding a hazard to skiers.

The tow is being purchased by the city.
