

WINTER SPORTS CLUB ORGANIZED

Edwin Lindquist Named President; Ski Tow Is Proposed

Munising, Oct. 10—Edwin G. Lindquist was elected president of a permanent Munising winter sports association formed at a meeting last night in the city hall. Mrs. Charles Symon was elected vice-president of the organization. Miss Freida Schwartz was chosen secretary and Vernon A. Floria was elected treasurer. Those who participated in the formation of plans for Munising's 1941 winter carnival were among those present at the meeting. Public membership in the organization is being invited and a campaign will be conducted for members with dues at \$1 a year. Buttons will be given members and they will be permitted to attend the winter carnival, carnival dance, and any other club parties without any charge.

Possibility of getting and financing a ski tow for the new winter sports area in Brown's Addition which the Cleveland-Cliffs Iron company has leased to the Munising Ski club was discussed but no definite action was taken. It was decided to follow a patriotic motif in the city's winter carnival this year.

First activity planned for the new winter sports organization is a hike to the new ski area on October 26 beginning at 2 o'clock for those who have joined or plan to join the organization. The next regular meeting of the group will be held on November 7.
