

Ski Meet Set At Bessemer

BESSEMER — A ski meet for Bessemer grade school students will be sponsored by the A. D. Johnston Alpine Ski Team on Saturday, March 12 beginning at 10 a.m. at the Mussatti Ski Hill.

Both downhill and slalom events are scheduled in three classes, one for girls and two for boys, as follows:

Class I—Girls—all ages through high school.

Class II—Boys—11 years through junior high age.

Class III—Boys 10 years old and below 10.

Medal awards will be issued to the five high scorers in each class. In classes one and two, downhill and slalom events will be combined in the scoring, for awards. In class three, medals will be awarded to the five high scorers in downhill, and the five high scorers in slalom events.

George Mussatti, on whose property the ski hill is located, north of US-2 in N. Ramsay, has installed a rope tow powered by a motor, which he has provided for public use, without charge. It is noted that the tow will be in operation during the ski meet.

Boys and girls interested in taking part in this event, may register with either James Ryerson, ski coach, or Paul Mascotti, or John Thors, before Saturday; or may enter prior to the meet on Saturday.

The purpose of the event, said Mascotti and Thors, is to encourage and to help younger students in the sport of skiing.

Meet managers will be Coach Ryerson and members of the Alpine Squad, including, in addition to Paul Mascotti and John Thors, David Paynter, Robert and David Hakkinen, William Romo, Robert Works, Tom Johnson, Myron Re, Jim Cosgrove, and Raymond Koski.
