

Toledo Ski Club To Operate 1,000 Foot Tow Near Adrian

Monroe memberships in the recently organized Toledo Ski Club are sought by W. A. Andrews, president. Purpose of the club, he explained, is to foster and develop interest in skiing throughout northwestern Ohio and southeastern Michigan.

The only skiing facility in the area, he pointed out, is Prospect Hill northwest of Adrian. The Toledo club is purchasing a 1,000-foot ski tow at the site. It will be operated week-ends, holidays, and week-days throughout the Christmas season—snow permitting.

The club will conduct a ski school at Prospect Hill with the express objective of teaching basic

techniques to beginners. Movies of interest to skiers will be shown occasionally in the Secor Hotel club room, Toledo. Next movies follow a business meeting at 8 p. m., Dec. 9. Interested persons from Monroe are invited to attend.

Ski trips to northern Michigan also will be sponsored, with the club arranging reservations for lodging and club discounts for ski facilities and transportation. The club is a recognized member of the Central United States Ski Association, an affiliate of the National Ski Association.
