

WILL BUILD SKI TOW

Marquette — A \$2,000 winter sports development program, of which the Marquette Winter Sports club will pay approximately one-third, was approved by the city commission last night.

Major projects will be construction of a ski-tow just west of the toboggan slide on Superior Hills, building of a roadway from the Sands road to the foot of the ski jump at Kirlin hill and an adjacent parking area.

The department of public works will furnish a 30-horsepower motor to operate the ski-tow and the Winter Sports club will pay for the rest of materials used. Including labor, it is estimated that the cost of the ski-tow, exclusive of the motor, will be \$1,470, which will provide for wiring at a cost of \$950.

Cost of repairs to the ski slide have been estimated at \$160 and the roadway will be built for approximately \$350.
