

Club to Operate Grayling Park

State Drafts Pact with Sportsmen

LANSING — (U.P.) Preparations for operation of a Michigan Winter Sports area at Grayling have been completed with drafting of an agreement between the State Conservation department and Grayling Sportsmen's club.

The sportsmen's club, a non-profit organization, will operate the state park with community support and workmen are now preparing to recondition machinery used for return of toboggans on six natural slides. Any profits from operation of the facilities will be used for park improvements.

In addition, department officials announced today that the Flint Ski club will participate in development of an experimental winter sports program in the Ortonville State Recreation area.

A similar development by the Pontiac Ski club on Teeple hill in the Highland State Recreation area already is underway. Slopes are being brushed and a ski tow being erected.

Improvements in both recreation areas will be open to the public.
