

Snowmobile Races Set For Hart

Snowmobile enthusiasts from all over the state are expected to converge on the Hart area in western Michigan Jan. 2-3 to get the new year started with two Class B. races sanctioned by the Michigan International Snowmobile Assn.

Whiskey Creek Recreation, a newly organized winter recreation area featuring a mile-long La Manz style banked track, will host racers on Saturday, Jan. 2. Whiskey Creek is located in southern Mason County about 20 miles north and east of Hart.

On the following day, Jan. 3, the Hart Jaycees will sponsor their annual snowmobile race at the Oceana Fairgrounds in Hart.

Fourteen classes of snowmobile races will be held each day, and prize money will total \$1,000 each day. In addition, \$200 will be given to the top point-getter during the combined two days of racing. Trophies will be awarded in addition to the cash prizes.
