INDIANHEAD MT., Bessemer, Mich.—8-inch base, 2 inches new snow; skiing good.

LOCKHAVEN, Spooner, Wis.—Hauling snow, 1/2-inch new, open daily through Jan. 2; free group instruction.

LOCH LOMOND, Fort William, Canada—4-inch base, one inch new snow; skiing fair to good.

LUTSEN, Lutsen, Minn.—One inch new snow; skiing poor to fair.

MOON VALLEY, Shakopee — Machine-made snow on north hill only.

MONT DU LAC, Duluth, Minn.—Up to 3 inch base, one inch new snow, skiing fair.

MT. ASHAWABAY, Boyfield, Wis.—4-inch base, 3-6 inches new snow, skiing good.

MT. LA CROSSE, La Crosse, Wis.—4-6 inches base, 2 inches surface powder every morning; 90 per cent artificial; skiing good.

RIB MT., Wausau, Wis.—4-8 inch base, lower slopes only; skiing good.
