

Arrangement Sought on Hummel Ski Tow

Representatives of the Omaha Ski Club met with Park and Recreation Superintendent Ralph McClintock Monday to work out an agreement on the Hummel Park ski tow.

The Park Department operated the tow until two seasons ago, Mr. Clintock said. But he said that it felt the skiers were too few to justify the expense.

Last year the ski club operated its own tow. But skiers who were not in the club got a free ride. There was also the question of liability.

Mr. McClintock said the city was agreeable to letting the club make a charge for use of the tow and also would pay the club a sum of money to be used for obtaining insurance.
