

## Hidden Ridge Ski Slope Opens With Return Of Snow

Tuscarawas county's first and only ski slope is in full operation presently following the nod from "Old Man Winter" with Friday's overload of the real-thing — snow.

Hidden Ridge Ski Slope, located on County Road 314 off SR. 39 west of this city, is owned and operated by the Dover Ski Corp., and managed by Architect Don Newland of Dover.

Local ski enthusiasts can turn out day or night on the slope, which has an electrically driven rope tow and flood lights.

Newland and his wife, Marian also own and operate "The Ski Shoppe" at 215 Walnut st, Dover, along with another shop at the slope. They have a complete stock of imported brand name skis, boots and poles for sale or rent.

The Hidden Ridge Ski Slope also furnishes soups and hot chocolate in addition to a lounge and restaurant menu. Besides skiing a winter sportsman can enjoy sledding and ice skating.
