

Skiing Returns to Canton Area

Skiing will be open to the public on a membership basis this year at the Canton Ski Club's run east of Newton Hills.

Stockholders in the ski corporation voted last week to offer a limited number of season memberships to the public for skiing at the run, which was constructed last year.

Members of the club constructed a long rope tow a year ago, and this year have had the run extended by bulldozing a clearing through trees at the top of the hill. The rope tow has also been extended, and additional trails cleared.

Officers of Canton Ski Club, Inc., were reelected at the club's annual meeting. They are Blaine Rudolph, president, Dr. Paul Hohman, vice president, and John Vickerman, secretary-treasurer.

Persons interested in joining the club should contact one of the officers, Rudolph said. The club's run is located on land owned by Merrill Gardner of Beloit and Larsgaard Brothers of Fairview.
