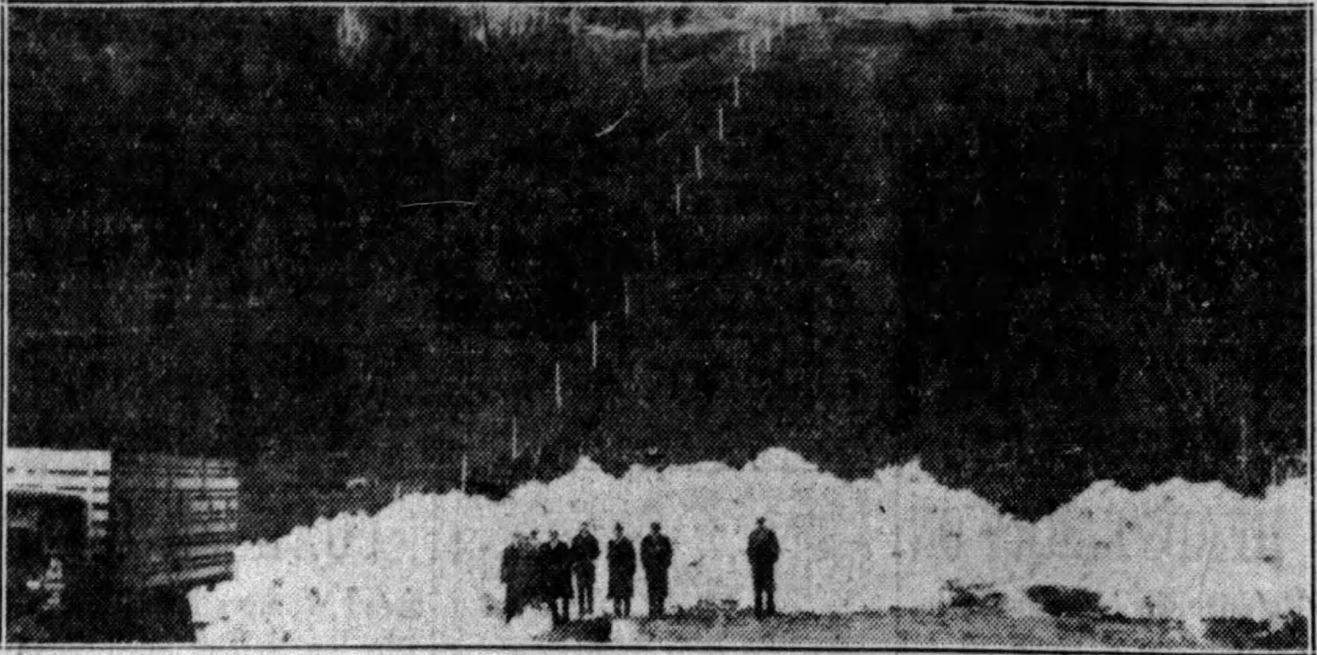


One Day's Delivery of Snow to Canton Ski Hill



Canton, Jan. 29.—The first day's "haul" of snow for the Central Championship ski tournament to be held at Canton Sunday. A fleet of 20 trucks are on the road day and night transporting the snow from Lake Okoboji to the giant ski hill at Canton, a distance of nearly 100 miles.

Secretary Knudsen of the local ski club says that the snow is of exceptionally good quality and that hauling will continue the rest of the week although under ordinary conditions there is already enough on hand to assure the ski meet. The snow is being stored on the north side of the hill where the sun does not strike it and even the mild weather of the past few days has had no effect on it.
