

Skiing to Open At 'Sun Valley' And Rib Mountain

Good news to ski enthusiasts is that both the "Little Sun Valley" and Rib mountain ski tows will be in operation this year.

The "Little Sun Valley" tow, located six miles out of Rhinelander, has been changed to a new location and is now longer and has a better run. The new tow will be 560 feet long and will be open to the public as soon as snow conditions on the run are right.

Even though the present equipment at the Rib mountain ski tow may be taken over by the U. S. army ski troops, there will be a tow in operation this year, it was announced last week after a meeting of the Rib mountain committee of the Wausau Chamber of Commerce.

The shelter house on the big hill will also be open and the toboggan chute will be operated by the Wausau Ski club this year under the direction of Henry Gunzel, caretaker of the Wausau recreational area, it was stated.

The committee also decided to form a ski patrol in coordination with the civilian service section of the Marathon county council of defense. This will be the first such organization in the state.
